## Whole School - guideline for boys' hair

Boys - Acceptable hairstyles

$1^{\text {st }}$ picture: Blended and number 3
$2^{\text {nd }}$ picture: Faded slick back - appropriate length/style/colour
$3^{\text {rd }}$ picture: Slightly shorter, faded but appropriate length

Boys - Unacceptable hairstyles

$1^{\text {st }}$ picture: Extreme colour on top, skin fade not allowed, too short.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ picture: Shaved line not allowed

## Unacceptable hairstyles

Hair must not impede vision / eyes. Long fringes or styles that cover the eyes are not allowed.


Please note that these images are just examples, the final decision regarding inappropriate hairstyles is at the discretion of the Heads of Year.

## Sixth Form Uniform Policy (Year 12 \& 13)

Sixth Form students are expected to support Dubai British School by wearing "approved business attire" smartly and in the spirit of the business environment. Sixth Formers are role models for younger pupils and the way they dress is very important to the whole school. Expectations are based around the type of clothes and appearance that would be accepted in the workplace.

## Compulsory Items

Trousers, Skirts, Dresses, Jumpers and Blazers: either plain/one colour, with understated, traditional pattern. (no logo jumpers or hoodies)

Shirts or Polo Shirts: Not tight fitting, or low rise

## Male Students

## Female Students <br> - Smart formal blouse or collared shirt, short or

- Shirts or Polo shirts short or long-sleeved
- Smart full-length trousers
- Plain black/brown/dark navy formal leather or leatherstyle shoes long-sleeved but not sleeveless, with a fairly high neckline
- Smart full-length trousers
- Smart skirt, knee-length or below the knee
- Dresses, with capped, short or long sleeves and a fairly high neckline, knee-length or longer
- Plain black/brown/dark navy formal leather or leather- style lowheeled* or flat shoes


## Optional (Male/Female)

- Tie, solid coloured or with understate, traditional pattern
- Plain belt with modest buckle
- Long-sleeved jumper or cardigan, finely knit
- Jacket or blazer


## Jewellery, Piercings, Make-up and Hairstyles

- 2 pairs of stud earrings - two per ear max
- 1 plain bracelet, 1 plain necklace, 1 ring, 1 watch
- Clear nose or cartilage piercing
- Make-up should be subtle and natural, and nail varnish may be worn but colours must be subtle and natural*
- Hair should be neat and tidy at all times, and hair colour should be on the natural colour spectrum*


## Not Permitted

Tight-fitting or revealing items
Tops displaying large logos, lettering
Jeans/denim-like material or skinny trousers
Skirts above the knee or excessive skirt slits
Bare midriffs and off-the shoulder blouses with low necklines
Prominent nose studs
Visible tattoos
Visible undergarments
High heels, trainers or canvas shoes
