Term 1 topic: Foundation Skills

The Formal Elements, Drawing Skills and Sketchbook Presentation

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Work from observation to understand space, form, texture, shape, line, tone and composition
- Work in a range of media to draw from observation
- Learn how to look at, and record responses to objects
- Learn how to discuss the work of artists and designers using specialist vocabulary

Term 2 topic: Everyday Objects

Apply skills from the previous project and explore a range of media to create a response to the work of 'Jim Dine'.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Develop ability to record from observation in a range of media
- Apply understanding of tone to create a range of observational studies.
- Improve ability to discuss the work of others using specialist language
- Practice applying techniques of artists to personal responses.

Term 3 topic: Natural Forms

Apply skills from the previous two projects to develop a response to the theme 'Natural Forms'

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Develop ability to record from observation in a range of media
- Apply understanding of colour theory to a range of work
- Improve ability to discuss the work of others using specialist language
- Practice applying techniques of artists to personal responses.

A painting and drawing project which will use the architecture of Dubai as its stimulus and the artwork of Hundertwasser as creative focus.

Assessment Objective Overview

Through this component, students must:

- Develop ideas through investigations, demonstrating critical understanding of sources (AO1)
- Refine work by exploring ideas, selecting and experimenting with appropriate media, materials, techniques and processes (AO2)
- Record ideas, observations and insights relevant to intentions as work progresses (AO3)
- Present a personal and meaningful response that realises intentions and demonstrates understanding of visual language (AO4).
