INCLUSION SUPPORT

Our vision 'Enjoy, Aspire, Achieve' applies to every student who attends DBS Emirates Hills.

Since our establishment, we have prided ourselves on being an inclusive school supporting a diverse range of pupil needs. We are proud to have a strong inclusion team of Teachers and Learning Assistants, with a wide range of expertise, skills and qualifications to ensure that every student's needs can be identified swiftly and supported appropriately.

Early intervention is a key factor in determining student success. This, alongside strong parent partnerships, are essential components of our support strategy. Therefore, if you have a concern regarding your child's learning please do speak to your child's teacher in the first instance. Our staff will be able to best advise you on how to take your concern forward. Equally if our staff have any concerns about your child they will raise them directly with you before proceeding with any intervention.

Where students do need an additional layer of support, we ensure that parents' gueries and concerns about their child's development are discussed openly and thoroughly before putting a support plan in place. Once these conversations have happened together, the school and parents collaborate to devise a personalised educational plan for their child, which meets both the child's academic and pastoral needs.

The nature and level of the support we offer depends on the needs of your child and can be short or long term, individual or group, within the classroom or outside of the classroom. We tailor support for every child differently. Rigorous monitoring procedures around every intervention ensure that however we are supporting your child, we know that it is making an impact. Additionally, the traditional curriculum is not always suited to all. Consequently we can also offer bespoke curriculum pathways to meet every student's needs.

If more specialised intervention is required we liaise closely with outside agencies including educational psychologists, occupational therapists and speech therapists. These agencies work in partnership with both the teachers and parents, offering advice and guidance on adaptations that may be required.

We are committed to nurturing every pupil and empower successful, well rounded individuals, equipping them with the skills essential for life-long learning.

For our students in FS2, Year 1 and Year 2, we tailor the beginning of the term quite carefully to facilitate a smooth and successful start, ensuring that our younger learners feel happy and confident coming to school for the rest of the year. The following dates are for our **Foundation Stage 2**, **Year 1 and Year 2 students only**. (Year 3 to Year 13 timings are shared in their respective Parent Handbooks).

Please follow your school calendar from here as there are professional development days and other holidays on which your child will not have school



LATE ARRIVALS:

Students in Year 1 and 2 are required to be in class by 7.40am. If arriving late, parents must report to Reception. Students will not be able to access classes without first visiting Reception and collecting a 'Late' slip.

ABSENCES AND SICKNESS

If a student is absent, please phone the Reception team on: **04 361 9361** before 8:00am and the reason will be recorded. Alternatively please email your child's Class Teacher and copy in the nurses: nurseclinic@dubaibritishschool.ae.

If your child is seriously unwell, please keep your child at home until they are fit to attend school.

Children must be fever-free and free from diarrhoea and vomiting for a full 24 hours before returning to school after illness. After 3 consecutive days of absence, a doctor's note will need to be provided.

EMERGENCY LEAVE or DOCTOR APPOINTMENTS:

Medical appointments should be arranged after school. However, we understand that this is not always possible and where this is the case please inform the Class Teacher and Reception on: **04 361 9361** or email: **reception@dubaibritishschool.ae.**

School Life at DBSEH

LUNCHES, SNACKS AND BREAKS

Students can bring their own packed lunches and snacks. We encourage a healthy eating policy, therefore please do not include chocolate, sweets, carbonated or caffeinated drinks as part of your child's packed lunch or snacks. Students will have a morning break of 15 minutes and lunch break of 40 minutes. Please ensure your child has a labelled water bottle which they are able to refill in school.

Please note that we have students on site with fatal nut and sesame seed allergies. Nuts and sesame seed products, such as Nutella and hummus, must not be included in packed lunches. We are also a pork free school.





BACKPACKS

Students must bring their own backpack. Please note the 'wheelie' luggage type bags on wheels are **not** permitted due to space in cubbies.

CUBBIES

FS and Primary students each have an open cubby where they can place their belongings during the day.

All belongings including backpack, lunch bag, hat, water bottle etc must fit in their allocated cubby, to keep the hallways clear, as a matter of health and safety.

STATIONERY

Stationery is provided at no extra cost, but children may wish to bring their own pencil cases and stationery in Years 1-6.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Foundation and Primary have PE twice weekly and will wear PE kits to school on their designated day - your child's class teacher will inform you of these.

When your child's PE group is doing swimming, your child will wear his or her PE kit to school and change into swimwear at school. Swimming blocks will be announced via email. Please remind your child to wear their PE kit on the relevant day, as lessons will begin on the first day of the new term.



EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (ECAS)

DBS offers a wide variety of ECAs for Year 1 and 2. You will receive the ECA options for each term by email after the term starts, along with instructions on how to sign up. Many of our ECAs are run by staff and there is no fee for these but we also offer ECAs run by external companies who require a fee for participation. Further information on ECAs will be released in due course.







DUBAI PERFORMING ARTS

We are also proud partners of the DPA Academy and can offer peripatetic vocal lessons to students. Just as with CMA, these are charged termly and take place on a rotating timetable throughout the school day. For more information, please email info@dubaiperformingarts.com

WELCOME FROM THE MEDICAL TEAM

Dear Parents,

We would like to extend a very warm welcome to all students and their parents. We are looking forward to working with you and your children here at Dubai British School Emirates Hills. To ensure your child's health and safety we would like to share a few points with you.

We shall be present at all times during the school day to administer first aid as required. Children who are taken ill at school will be cared for by us until they are fit enough to return to class or a parent/guardian can be contacted and arrangements made for them to be collected and taken home.

Please also be aware that children are not allowed to go home via taxi unless escorted by a parent/guardian. The expected pick up time is 15-20 minutes.

If your child has a persistent condition, allergy or medical condition that the school should be aware of, please specify in detail the nature of the condition, the signs and symptoms and any medication that may need to be administered.

If you have not completed the school's medical form, please ensure that this is completed and returned, along with a copy of all childhood vaccinations, prior to schools commencement.


